Purpose: The purpose of the Outstanding Scrapbook is to plan yearly activities in keeping with the goals and purpose of FPSA as described in FPSA Handbook and provide the opportunity:

1. To encourage the development of local club activities that benefits the student, the school, and the community.
2. To provide documentation of the chapter's activities at the local level.
3. To give recognition to those chapters that fulfills these aims and purposes to the highest degree.

Description of Event: The FPSA **SCRAPBOOK** is to be prepared by FPSA student members describing the chapter's yearly program of activities that are consistent with the purpose of FPSA. It must include such items as: verification of membership, officers, local activities participation, state participation, and community activities.

Limit: 1 entry per chapter

Dress Code: Appropriate dress to include; business attire, chapter uniform or other attire appropriate for the competition, or as directed by your chapter advisor.

Rules:

1. The scrapbook must be turned in by a student at the designated time and location at the State Conference. The scrapbook will be judged later and announced at the Awards Ceremony. Scrapbooks will be on display at the Awards Ceremony.
2. Contestant numbers and order of presentations are assigned on a random selection basis.
3. All entries are limited to 100 pages or less, counting each page/side as one page (100 single or 50 double-sided).
4. Each scrapbook must have:
 - a. a cover page with the following information:
 - i. Name of the Chapter
 - ii. Name of the Program (FF or CJ or TA)
 - iii. Name of the School
 - iv. City, state, and zip code
 - b. Table of contents
 - c. Chapter Membership Status (copy of Charter)
 - d. Introduction of members
 - e. Installation of officers
 - f. Current officers
 - g. Leadership activities
 - h. State Activities (regional and state)
 - i. Alumni Members
 - j. Community Service



- k. Cooperative Projects
- l. Social Activities
- m. Other Activities
- n. Publicity
- o. Date of the first activity (Activities may begin with the State Leadership Conference from the past spring and continue to the State Leadership Conference for the current school year.)
- p. The pages must be numbered sequentially.
- q. All material must be the work of a chapter member or members. All copy content must be typed or clearly handwritten. Photocopies may be used.
- r. Tie breakers are determined by adding a total of 20 possible points for originality, neatness, clarity, and presentation.
- s. All scrapbooks will be on display at the Awards Ceremony.
