



## Team Dynamics

Purpose: To gain experience in interpersonal skills and leadership through teamwork and management.

Description of Event: One team at a time will be led into the room where they will be given their task directions. They will not receive advance notice of the task which they are to perform. The instructions for the tasks will be provided either verbally by the judges, or will be written down on a piece of paper furnished to the team. Teams will be supplied with all materials and equipment, which will enable them to perform the tasks.

Limit: 1 team of 4 per chapter.

Dress Code: Appropriate dress to include; business attire, chapter uniform or other attire appropriate for the competition, or as directed by your chapter advisor.

### Rules:

1. To be eligible for the competition a student must be enrolled in a secondary public service education program or a program completer as recognized by Florida Department of Education.
2. This event is only open to students in Teacher's Assistant chapters of FPSA.
3. Each team will consist of exactly four (4) students.
4. Teams will be monitored at all times of the competition by all present judges.
5. Students may not leave the competition room for any reason. Exiting the room will result in disqualification of the team.
6. All team members must actively participate in the solution to the tasks.
7. The judges will have the final decision on all scores and tie-breakers.
8. Competitors will be judged on speed and accuracy of their solution to the given tasks, the extent of their teamwork, and the rank of their quantitative score in comparison with the other competing teams.
9. Competitors may not bring any materials with them to the competition room.
10. Tasks vary from year to year.
11. Teams are **absolutely forbidden** to discuss their tasks at any time until competition for this event has ended for the year.

### Required Personnel:

1. One Timekeeper
2. Two - three judges to record scores
3. One Courtesy Corps member

Facilities and Equipment: One room of a size determined to be adequate for the judges and all related personnel to occupy at the same time.

Materials relevant to annual tasks (to be determined each year).
